

## **Gardening by the Moon**

Please note that these interpretations are a combination of traditional approaches used in planting by the lunar cycles and positions of the Moon, and are intended for experimental purposes only and are therefore provided in good faith and without any warranty as to their fitness of use.

### **Gardening by the Moon – Technical Information.**

The interpretations cover three aspects of the Moon's position, 1. the Lunar Phase, that is the Moon's relative position to the Sun, which determines the amount of the Moon's face that is lit by the Sun as visible from the earth; 2. the longitudinal position of the Moon on the celestial equator, the 360 degrees of which has been divided according to tradition into 12 equal sections of 30 degrees each which are designated by individual zodiac signs; 3. and the height of the Moon above and below the celestial equator which determines the apparent height of the Moon in the sky, these are traditionally expressed respectively as the Moon Riding High and the Moon Running Low.

Please note that there are two separate sets of interpretations provided, one set for the Northern hemisphere "Gardening\_by\_the\_Moon NH.txt" and one set for the Southern hemisphere "Gardening\_by\_the\_Moon SH.txt". The reason for this is that the Moon is higher – and lower - in the sky in these opposite hemispheres at opposite times. So please select the correct hemisphere for your location.

Also note that the phases of the Moon in these interpretations are determined by the relevant Moon days, and although the use of ranges of degrees to select the lunar phases in ZET would have probably provided greater accuracy, I considered that this accuracy would be beyond the needs of the interpretations' intended use. In addition, this approach gives me the flexibility to add some special Moon day related information at a later stage.

### **Setup Instructions.**

This archive contains the Northern and Southern hemisphere interpretation files "Gardening\_by\_the\_Moon NH.txt" and "Gardening\_by\_the\_Moon SH.txt", as well as the associated setup file "Gardening and farming.bib". Please copy these files into the "ZET 9\language\english\txt\" directory.

Set the interpretation settings in ZET as follows: 1. for the displayed natal chart, 2. generate a Web document, 3. interpret in planet order. The other settings are up to you.
